Thursday, Oct 20, 2022, 6:30pm – 8:30pm: Open Sew/Finish Sewing Caddy

You will need three fabrics -

- 5/8 yard focus fabric: This will be your main fabric that shows on the outside.
- 5/8 yard companion fabric: This should coordinate with focus fabric, but perhaps be less busy. It will make the pocket flaps, contrasting pockets, and the binding.
- 10" high x 20" wide base: This will be used as the base for inside pockets. Very little of it will show. It is best if it is a tone-on-tone coordinate or similar.
- Other: Batting, 2 @ 10" x 20" very lightweight batting (like Hobbs Thermore)
4 buttons (3 @ 5/8", 1 @ 5/8 - 7/8") OR sew in Velcro
1-1/2 yards ribbon (3/8" wide) for ties
- Rotary cutting supplies: mat, cutter, ruler (6x24, and 12x12 if available)
- Sewing Supplies: Sewing machine in good working order. You will be doing straight stitching and optionally making buttonholes. A walking foot will help you attach the binding.
- Standard sewing supplies: Thread, scissors, seam ripper, hand & machine needles, pins, turning tool
